Expectations

1. Abides by and promotes Agency administrative policies.

5. When necessary, works on additional projects within scope of knowledge, as requested by Clinical Supervisor, Director of Clinical Services or Agency Administration.
6. Participates in activities and supports agency policies and procedures designed to maintain continuous Quality Improvement throughout the agency.
7. Reports incidents, accidents and emergencies promptly to the immediate supervisor or his/her designee. Prepares documentation of the events when requested by the Agency. Institutes appropriate emergency measures and notifies appropriate person(s) within a reasonable time frame.
8. Maintains cooperative relationships with agency employees, supervisors, and administration.
9. Complies with employee health requirements.
10. Conveys a positive image of agency when in contact with patients, families, and community at large.
